Steps in the event of a phone scam:

- **Never** panic and give a credit or debit card over the phone [or follow any direction dictated by the phone scammer].
- **Secure** a call back number – and hang up.
- **Call** LPEA immediately to clarify any account discrepancies – 970.247.5786 – and report the scam.
- **If** the caller is threatening or aggressive, contact the police.
